Uniform Standards

Year 7 THRIVE Day - Wednesday 17th April

Year 7 students took place in a Study Skills THRIVE day on Wednesday. Subject teachers presented sessions on study habits and strategies. This is to support students to consolidate their learning and to prepare for their summer assessments in term 6. Students have been introduced to the Pomodoro technique - a method to split revision into manageable bitesize chunks. They were also given the opportunity to practise different study strategies in their subject lessons. These included; the making and using of flashcards, mind mapping and blurting (otherwise known as a brain dump). The aim of the sessions was to show students that the same strategies can work for a wide range of subjects.
