Derbyshire County Council Household Support Fund

Key Stage 3

DofE Bronze

Students can now submit their proposals for physical, skill and volunteer via their eDofE account. The app can be downloaded and makes the process of adding evidence easy. Students need to complete their activity for an hour each week and then they can add evidence to their account in the form of a photo, screen shot or text entry. The assessor must be an adult who is <u>not</u> related to the child in any way and someone who at the end of the section can confirm the relevant activity has been completed.

If your child is still looking for a skill activity, the English faculty offer a reading challenge called 'for the love of books'. Students simply have to select a series of books to read, write a short review and get their record card stamped. This is a fantastic example of a skill activity, one that is accessible to all students and can easily be completed over 3 or 6 months. Students should speak to Miss Osbildeston for more information and to sign up.

DofE meeting's take place every Monday 3 to 4pm in the computer rooms and students can get 1:1 help with their activities during these sessions.

Year 11 Trial Exams

Students should attend the full school day as normal throughout these trial exams. Some lessons will continue as timetabled in between exams, as some vocational courses are not holding exams on this occasion. Your child's teachers will share revision topics and exam information with the students via classroom and information on how to revise can be found on the school website.

If an afternoon exam finishes before 2.30pm students will return to their Period 5 lesson, however if an exam finishes between 2.30 and 3pm, they will be permitted to leave the site early that day, unless their vocational course teacher has requested they attend their lesson.
